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## You will need:

- A nice piece of paper (any size will do, the bigger the easier to work with)
- Some glue and a brush (PVA is best)
- A ruler
- 10 minutes


## Instruction Steps:

1. Start with the side of paper you want on the outside of the bag TOWARDS THE TABLE
2. Put your piece of paper in LANDSCAPE orientation
3. Fold the sides towards the middle to OVERLAP by approx. 2 cm
4. GLUE this overlap and wait for it to DRY
5. Fold the sides in to ONE WIDTH of the ruler
6. Now fold these widths INWARDS to make the $<\&>$ shape sides for the bag
7. Now to the bottom of the bag...
8. Measure TWO WIDTHS of the ruler and fold here
9. Measure ONE more WIDTH with the ruler and fold again
10. OPEN up the bottom of the bag to the THIRD fold
11. Press down inside this ' $B O X$ ' to make side triangles and a FLAT BOTTOM on both sides
12. Press down the sides of this 'box' to make the SIDES FLAT
13. Turn your bag to PORTRAIT orientation
14. FOLD UP the bottom part of the bag's bottom
15. FOLD DOWN the top part of the bag's bottom so that they OVERLAP
16. GLUE in place (put glue on the whole of the top part of the bag's bottom)
17. Put your hand inside to OPEN it up
18. WELL DONE - YOU'VE DONE IT!

Note: For each fold in Steps 5,8 \& 9 it's worth using the ruler to 'enforce' the fold and to fold the paper both backwards \& forwards. This will look neater and make it easier to do the foldings.

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
